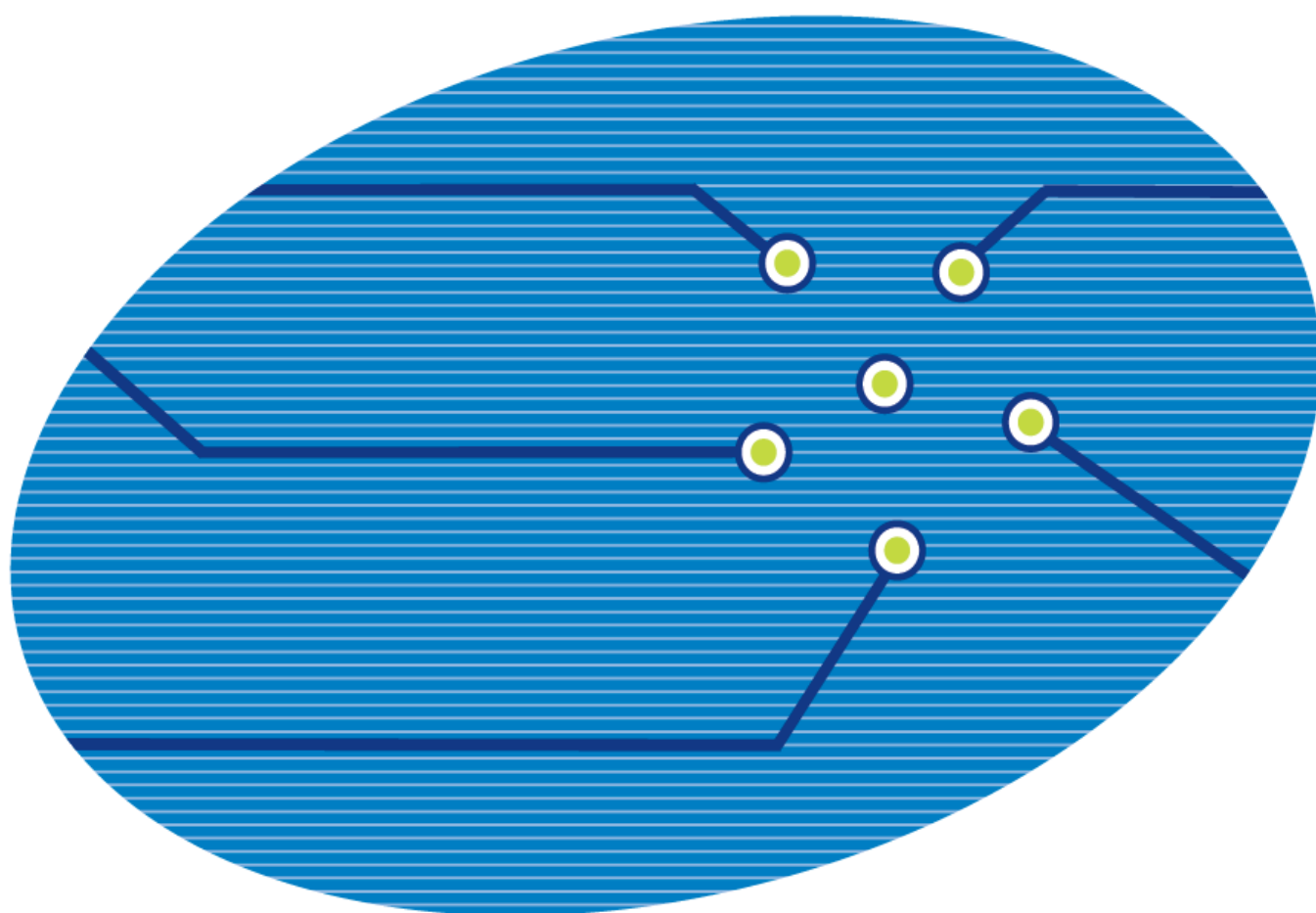

Costs and Financial Support

There are several different kinds of saver tickets available to students and we have detailed below the most popular ones:

Our Pass



Greater Manchester residents aged 16-18-year-old are eligible for this new bus pass, which gives students **free travel** on all local bus services across Greater Manchester for a one off £10 administration fee.

Our Pass can be used 7 days a week and has no time restrictions. It is valid from Sunday 1 September 2019 and allows access to lots of opportunities, experiences and benefits. For more information or to apply online visit <https://ourpass.co.uk>.

Stagecoach Uni-riders

If you are not a Greater Manchester resident but still travel on Stagecoach or Magic Bus services, you may be interested in a Uni-rider. This is a student only bus ticket valid on all Stagecoach and Magic Bus services in Greater Manchester and into the surrounding areas of Derbyshire and Cheshire, e.g. the 358 to New Mills/Hayfield.

The Unirider is valid at weekends and at night and there are no age restrictions – but you must show your student photo ID to the driver every time you travel. It can be used between the 2 dates printed on the ticket by showing it to the driver with your student ID card.

You can purchase the following termly saver tickets* from college:

Term 1	£120	1 September 2019 - 31 December 2019
Term 2	£90	1 January 2020 - 31 March 2020
Term 3	£90	1 April 2020 - 30 June 2020

**Passes purchased in college will paper tickets that will incur a charge for replacement if lost.*

Please make cheques payable to Cheadle & Marple Sixth Form College.

*There may be further savings available from buying an annual ticket for £225 at www.stagecoachbus.com
This would be a plastic card that can be replaced free of charge if lost.*

Students that are not Greater Manchester residents, live more than 2 miles from college and are eligible for the 16-19 Bursary, may receive a Stagecoach Uni-rider or an equivalent fortnightly payment as part of their Bursary allocation.

System One Travel Cards

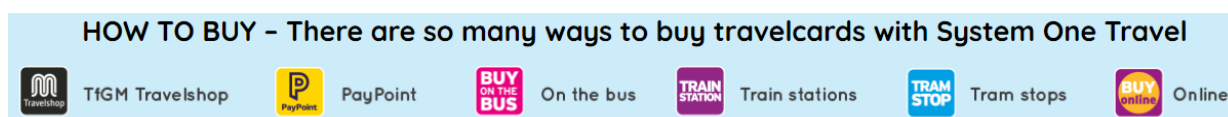
Students who do not qualify for the above passes can take advantage of System One Travel Cards. The Travel Cards enable students to travel with all bus operators in the Greater Manchester System One Travel Network and can be used in the evenings and at weekends.

Students do not have to live in the Greater Manchester area to apply for the System One pass but must board the bus within the Greater Manchester area.

Young Person Bus Saver 7* enables students aged between 16-21, to travel anywhere in Greater Manchester for 7 consecutive days, any time of day or night until 4 am. The cost of the pass is £14.00.

Young Person Bus Saver 28* enables students to travel monthly for a cost of £50 or £48 when purchased on line. www.systemonetravel.co.uk

Register at systemonetravel.co.uk and upload a recent passport photograph and your payment. Once a membership photo card has been purchased, weekly and monthly tickets can be renewed at any of the following:

Financial Support

Students living more than 2 miles from College whose household income is below £26,000 may qualify for help with travel costs from the 16-19 Bursary, if they cannot use the free college bus service.

If you do not qualify for the 16-19 Bursary but live a long distance from college and have high travel costs greater than £20 each week, you can apply for the Travel Bursary.

Hazel Grove residents

We have taken the hard decision to withdraw one of our services – the 396 from Stockport, through Hazel Grove and onto the College. The withdrawal of the service is due to low usage in the last academic year compared to the high cost of providing the service.

We understand that non-College public transport between Hazel Grove and Marple is not frequent, so we have put together a guide to some of the options in either direction:

Option 1

7.33am from Queen's Road – Bus service 394 Glossop to Cotefield Close arriving 7.52am

Option 2

7.53am from Queen's Road – Bus service 191 Albert Square to Longshut Lane, then

8.15am from Brentnall Street - Bus service 383 Romiley to Marple Swimming Pool walk 10 minutes arrive 8.48am

Option 3

7.35am from Hazel Grove train station to Manchester Piccadily, then

7.55am from Grand Central (Stop RR) – Bus service 383 Romiley to Marple Swimming Pool arrive 8.31am

Option 4 if timetable starts later in the day

9.38am from Queen's Road – Bus service 394 Glossop to Cotefield Close arriving 9.57am

1. Return 3.08pm Bus 394 from Cotefield Close arrive Queen's Road 3.25pm
2. Return 5.05pm Bus 394 from Cotefield Close arrive Queen's Road 5.25pm
3. Return 3.47pm Bus 375 from Cotefield Close arrive Springfield Avenue 4.22pm 15min walk to Hazel Grv
4. Return 4.14pm walk to Cross Lane 4.26pm Bus 384 arrive Nangreave Road 4.39pm then 4.49pm Bus 373 from Dialstone Road to Queen's Road 5.00pm
